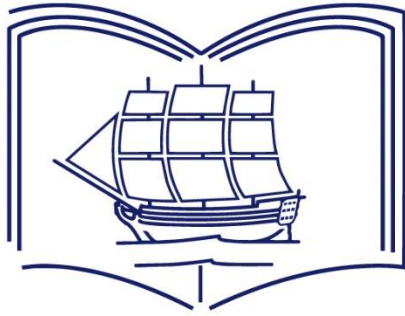

PSHE Curriculum

Whole School Overview

- At Victory Primary School we have a whole school approach towards PSHE. We have created a whole school progression of skills which means each year group covers a more challenging level of work than the year before them.
- The knowledge, skills and understanding are taught through interrelated themes. Building Relationships, Being Healthy and Living in the Wider World.
- Sessions include work on a range of topics, such as healthy living, keeping safe, drug and sex and relationships education. Our PSHE curriculum includes the new Statutory RSE guidance, which officially starts in September 2020.
- Links with other subjects are encouraged. Some aspects of PSHE are covered in more detail through the science curriculum, P.E and computing.
- The RSE curriculum at The Victory links to and is complementary to the ethos, values and principles of our school. It includes learning about the body, feelings, beliefs, relationships, rights and responsibilities and knowing how and when to ask for help if needed. It involves acquiring information, developing skills and forming positive beliefs, values and attitudes towards all members of the community.
