

Dear Parents and Carers,

Just a reminder about our art exhibition Wall of Love which is opening this week. To visit, can you please enter via the Community Entrance at the front of the school then leave via the playground entrance between the Hall and Nursery? To keep everyone safe, only 6 people can enter the exhibition at a time and they must keep 1 metre apart. Masks will need to be worn by adults. Friday 2nd October from 3:15pm until 5:00pm for Year 4

Monday 5th October from 3:45pm until 5:00pm for Year 5

Tuesday 6th October from 3:30pm until 5:00pm for Year 6

Wednesday 7th October from 3:30pm until 5:00pm for Rainbowfish 1 and 2

Thursday 8th October from 3:30pm until 5:00pm for Year 7

As with usual art exhibition practice, you can buy your child's artwork for a donation of your choice. We will mark it as 'sold' and keep it on display and you will then be able to collect it on Monday 12th October from your child's class. In addition to the original, you may also order any number of additional high quality colour copies for 50p each.

The masterpiece or copy provides a lasting memento of your child's time at The Victory Primary School and also makes a great present for birthdays and other special events.

If you are unable to attend on the day, you can still purchase your child's portrait by simply making an order and donation using the slip on the letter your child brought home. (If you already ordered and paid before lockdown, you can collect your child's work on 12.10.20)
