2. Use a tissue or elbow to cough or sneeze into.

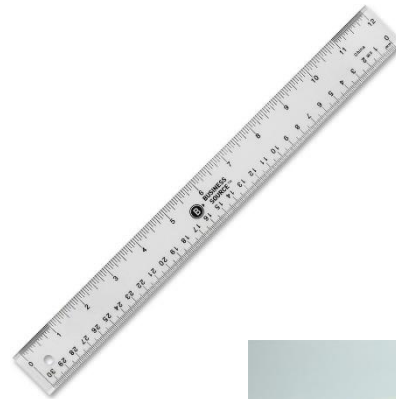
If I use a tissue put it in the bin.
